

Ship Howard Bound to the Eastward Sat 31.10 Lat 15.57

Saturday commences with moderate wind from the Eastward headed to the Southward blowing N 670 weather Middle Part, light air latter light air and rain weather tacked to the N 6 with the hold, Lat 30.34 Long 154.22

Sunday commences with light wind and fine the 16 weather clear and in morning rain N 671 tacked to the Southward to the Part tacked to the N 6 at 10th water to the Southward plenty of birds, Lat 30.10 Long 154.24

Monday First Part fresh wind from the Eastward Aug the 17 saw a ship steering by the wind to the N 672 N 6 Middle Part, head up S 8 E latter Part, the same employed in mending sail, and lashing rope, Lat 29.35 Long 154.33

Tuesday commences with a fine breeze from Aug the 18 E 8 steering by the wind to the N 673 S 8 mending sail, latter the same Lat 27.38 S Long 152.39

Wednesday First Part commences with moderate Aug the 19 wind from the Eastward tacked to the N 674 Montevideo at 5 P.M. wind increased double, pushed off to wind in morning for summer latter Part tacked to the S 8 the wind Montevideo tacked to the Northward Lat 28.49 Long

Thursday commences with moderate wind the 20 from the Eastward headed to the N 675 after the Middle Part tacked to the S 8 latter Part tacked to the N. sent up the fore top gallant mast and yard set the sail Lat Long

head wind, Head wind strong and fresh, passing and repassing where there has been thousands of birds of all kinds formerly Sunday commences with light wind from the Aug the 21 Eastward headed to the S 8, sent up N 676 the Mizzen to top gallant mast and yard set the sail Middle Part tacked to the South latter Part employed in filling rigging Lat 29.10 N Long 153.08

Friday First Part moderate wind from the the 22 steering by the wind to the Northward N 677 at wake on the rigging Middle Part light wind latter Part much the same head up N 6, Lat Long 153.23

Saturday First Part fresh wind from the Aug the 23 East wind at 5 P.M. took in the 678 fore and mizzen to top gallant sails Middle Part the wind light set the top gallant sails latter Part the same at wake below this day Lat 31 Long

Sunday commences with light air inclined to be the 24 calm Middle Part Part the same N 679 latter Part light air from the S 8 headed to the N 6 with the hold Lat 32.23 Long 153.57

Tuesday commences with light wind from Aug the 25 S 8 steering by the wind to the N 680 N 6 Middle Part latter Part light wind employed in turning up and rattring the fore rigging Lat 33.09 Long 154.33
