 Saturday the 31 Nov 31 getting off water and storing it away
 Sunday the 1 Dec 1 light breeze and fine weather

 the 14 N° 760 came on board & stored off at 8 under way
 sail ship & Part calm latter Part strong
 wind from N by E - very high sea
 Lat Long

Remarks on board Nov the 1840

Sunday commences with variable wind from N E to
 Nov the 15 South, Mid the Part the wind from the
 N° 761 Eastward latter Part freshen in storming
 to the SE Lat 14.15 Long 157.44 West

Monday first Part strong trade Mid and
 Nov the 16 latter Part the same storming & by
 N° 762 Lat 16 04 Long

Tuesday strong trade and squalls from N E
 the 17 steering at E by S Mid latter Part
 N° 763 same Lat Long

Wednesday first Part then 24 hours moderate
 Wednesday trade from N E & latter Part squalls
 Nov the 17 Lat 12.12 Nov the 18 Long

Thursday commences with strong trade storming
 the 18 N° 765 by the wind to the Southward Mid the
 and latter Part the same, Lat 10.14 Long

Friday first Part strong trade taking the
 the 19 N° 766 top gallant sail latter Part squalls
 attended with rain, Lat 8.28 Long 158.32

Saturday
 Nov the 20 first Part calm at 6 PM light sail from
 N° 767 the N E heaved to the N W Mid the Part
 baffling wind and rain latter the wind light
 and clear weather, Lat Long

Sunday commences with light wind from N E
 Nov the 21 saw porpoises Mid and latter Part
 N° 768 squalls of wind and rain from N E
 N° 769 this day
