Monday commenced with fresh wind from ESE
Nov the 22 cloudy Middle Part especially Latter Part
N^o 769 fresh breeze from SE steering by the
wind to the Southward, Lat 4.58. Long

Tuesday First Part fine breeze from the SE
the 23 clear weather Middle and Latter Part
N^o 770 the same saw five birds Lat 3 07 Long 155.36

Wednesday commenced with a fine breeze from SE
Nov the 24 saw porpoises in a fine bark at 10 AM
N^o 771 tacked to the Northward under short sail
at 2 PM tacked to the Southward under main sail
all hands employed in mending sail, Lat Long

Thursday First Part light wind and pleasant at 2
Nov the 25 PM saw three small boats coming from SE
N^o 772 to West. At 5 PM started off for the West
Part at 2 PM started by the wind to the Southward
fine weather Lat Long

Friday commenced with moderate wind from
N^o 773 the SE, employed in mending sail.
Nov the 26 Latter Part light wind, Lat 10 miles N

Saturday First Part light wind from SE steering
Nov the 27 at 11 AM Middle and Latter Part the
N^o 774 same saw porpoises, Lat 00 32 Miles South

Sunday commenced with light wind steering to the
the 28 weather very pleasant the fore top sail.
N^o 775 at 1 PM tacked to the Northward
Middle and Latter Part light wind
saw 11 small boats, Lat 46 Miles
Long 167

Remarks on Board Ship "Hermes" 1840

Monday commenced with light wind and calm sea
Nov the 30 porpoises Middle Part and Latter calm
N^o 776 went to the Main to sail employed in
mending it; Lat 44 Miles Long 163.02

Tuesday First Part light wind from ESE
Lat 44 11 started by 1 PM to the top sail
N^o 777 Latter Part the same; Lat Long 164.11

Wednesday light wind saw a school of whales going
Lat 44 2 quick to the SE saw one and got 7 teeth
N^o 778 him along side Latter Part fine weather
the 11 in the whale began to be fat Long

Thursday First Part steering by the wind to the
the 35 Southward saw a whale going quick to the
N^o 779 N E saw one and got 10 teeth
mending at 10 PM finished sailing
Latter Part steering to the West Lat 2 15 57

Friday Moderate wind and fine weather steering
Lat 44 4 to the Westward saw black fish and porpoises
N^o 780 Latter Part light wind from ESE steering
West. Lat Long

Saturday commenced with light wind from the
the 5th Eastward steering N E saw porpoises Middle
N^o 781 and Latter Part the same; Lat 1.23 Long 169.07

Sunday Steady wind and weather; tacked to the
the 6th East, saw bunches Middle Part steering West
N^o 782 Latter Part saw whales going quick to the
Eastward did not strike
Lat Long
