Sunday commences with fine wind and
 the 3rd weather storming by the wind to the
 N 810 at 6 PM tacked to the North and short
 tened sail Lutter Part. the wind light at day
 light saw a ship at stern, Lat 3.31 Long 173.21

Monday First Part. light air and saw porpoises.
 and the 4th shortened sail Middle Part. calm
 N 811 Lutter Part. light air from S E
 headed to the S E, Lat 3.44 - - -

Tuesday commences with light wind
 the 5th head up and saw no whaler to be
 N 812 seen Lutter Part. a fine breeze
 saw porpoises Lat. Long

Wednesday Fine wind and weather a great
 and the 6th number of porpoises about. steering
 N 813 by the wind to the N E Lutter Part.
 the wind N W steered S W Lat. Long 174.55

Thursday commences with a fine breeze from S E
 the 7th steering S by N Middle Part. squally Lutter
 N 814 cloudy saw porpoises Lat 3.30
 Long 176.09

Friday commences with moderate wind from
 and the 8th North at 6 PM commences raining with
 N 815 a strong breeze took in the fore and main
 tops and fore sails, steering S by E Lutter
 Part. light baffling wind some rain 3 ships

Saturday commences with light air and calm
 the 9th rain to the N W some 3 ships in
 N 816 sight steering to the N W Lat. Long this day

Sunday commences with variable wind and squally
 and the 10 rain steering S E brought a whaler saw fine
 N 817 dark saw a whaler sail. Lat. Long thick and
 rain Lat. Long

Monday First Part. thick and hazy, picked up
 the 11 a canoe with 3 natives of Cook's Island
 N 818 at 4 PM saw whaler going for quick to be
 tacked to the S E Lutter Part. strong wind
 from N E saw whaler bearing the whaler
 going quick to the windward, Lat 2.40 Long 176.30

Tuesday commences with strong wind from S E hazy
 and the 12 headed by the wind to the S E Middle Part.
 N 819 the wind S W steered S E Lutter Part. headed N W
 saw a ship Lat. Long

Wednesday First Part. fresh breeze tacked to the Eastward
 the 13 spoke for the George Mifflin Part. a heavy
 N 820 squally from East. attended with rain
 Lutter Part. light air from N E headed
 to the Northward Lat. Long 176.44
