Thursday First Part fine wind from NE
 and the 14 sailed to the NE at 11 AM George in
 N° 821 company with Part. under Charles
 landed the 3 natives stored by the minute
 the southward Lat. 2. 51 Long 175. 55

Friday commences fine wind and weather landed
 the 15 to the 18 Middle and Latter Part fine
 N° 822 up to 888 Lat. 3. 51 Long 176. 34

Saturday First Part Moderate wind from NE
 from the 16 steering by the wind to the NE same for the
 N° 823 at 6 AM lay with the Regard aback
 at 2 PM steering South Latter Part
 the same Lat 5. 03 Long

Sunday commences with light wind storm
 the 17 at 8 AM at 2 PM headed to the Northward
 N° 824 with the Regard aback at 11 AM light
 saw on Island bearing NE at 9 AM
 saw Island bearing NE at 10 AM
 South true and in latitude 26. 18 - Long 176. 01

Monday First Part light wind from NE
 and the 18 steering by the wind Middle and Latter
 N° 824 Part the same, Lat Long

Tuesday commences with a moderate breeze
 the 19 and fine weather Latter Part the same
 N° 825 employed in fitting new sails, Lat 7. 35

Wednesday the first Part the wind from NE
 and the 20 at 6 AM with calm Middle Part raining the
 N° 826 under NE at Latter the wind to the South
 Lat 10 - 34 - Long 176. 44

Bround to the Southward Jan 1841

Thursday commences with light wind from
 and the 21 the southward bearing the wind
 N° 827 to the SE toward Middle Part light wind
 from NE steering by the wind to the same
 set all the steering sails Lat 11. 28 Long 177. 8-15

Friday First Part a fine breeze from NE at 6 AM
 the 22 saw the appearance of the wind light
 N° 828 under Middle Part lay aback Latter Part
 strong wind and rain, steered off by E, 12. 44

Saturday commences with light wind unvariable
 and the 23 thick and rain steering to the Southward
 N° 829 Middle Part calm Latter Part light
 from NE steering by the wind a shoal of water
 seen and struck the iron beam
 lost the wheel, Lat 13. 55 Long 177. 21

Sunday First Part light wind from NE steering
 the 24 at 11 AM Middle Part the same Latter Part
 N° 830 a squall of rain Lat 14. 54 Long 176. 58

Monday First Part a squall from NE steering
 and the 25 at 11 AM bearing Middle Part lay aback
 N° 831 a squall Latter Part steering by the wind
 NE at squall of rain, Lat 16. ... Long

Tuesday commences with a moderate breeze
 the 26 from the Southward Middle Part the
 N° 832 same Latter Part strong wind and
 rain from NE at 11 AM light saw
 a cluster of the fuge bearing NE at 1 PM
 began steering South to 10 at this day
