Monday commences with fine wind and weather
Feb the 1st steering by the wind to the southward
N^o 838 Middle Part and Latter Part fine
trades head up Feb 26. 06 Long 175. 29

Tuesday commences with fresh trades steering by
the 27 the wind the S.E. employed in mending
N^o 839 sails Middle and Latter Part head up
S.E. & mending sails blow Feb 27. 36

Wednesday First Part a fresh breeze from East
Feb the 28th raining moderately Middle Part the
N^o 840 same Latter Part a fresh breeze from
N.E. steering by the wind to the S.E.
Feb 28. 43 Long 177. 34

Thursday First Part fresh wind from S.E. & to the
land the 29 in the forenoon mending top sail
N^o 841 sails Middle and Latter Part the
same Feb 30. 23 Long 178. 33

Friday commences with the fresh wind from the
Feb the 30th eastward sent a new fore sail head
N^o 842 and Latter Part light air
Feb 32. 04 Long 178. 56
