

Remarks On board Ship *Thetis* April 1841

Wednesday First Part a moderate gale from NW steering
April the 17th at 8 AM under double reefed fore and main top
sails, and fore sail, blew moderate, at 5 PM the reef
out. The top gallant sail, top mast, steering sail, set
at 8 AM sail set at 1 PM the wind NW blowing strong,
double reefed the top sails took in the jib reefed the
main sail, set it again at 10 PM the wind increased to a gale
took in the fore and main top sails, Lat 36.57 Long 36.12

Thursday These 24 hours commenced with a gale from NW
the 18th headed to the NW under double reefed main top sail and
fore sail. Middle and Latter Part, blowing a heavy
gale at 4 PM took in the main top sail the wind
WNW the ship making considerable water
Lat. Long

Friday commenced with a strong gale from NW
the 19th headed up at 5 PM the wind NW set the fore
sails and the top sails stored off at 10 PM all
sail set the wind moderate Latter Part light wind
the hands employed in breaking out, Lat 34.30

Saturday commenced with light wind from NW
the 20th at the jib boom in and began the spirit
sail yard, Middle and Latter Part the same
Lat 33.11 Long

Sunday First Part light wind from West to South
the 21st rigged out the jib boom set the sail the fore
sails to sea, Middle Part the wind SE and light
signals of rain Latter Part a fresh breeze and
signals at 5 PM saw a ship at 9 PM the Rose
of Antwerp with west bound home
Lat 31.20
Long

Monday commenced with a strong wind
the 22nd from SE steering NW all sail set the fore
sails in sight Middle and Latter Part the same
the Rose in company Lat 28.46 Long 30.11

Tuesday commenced with a moderate breeze
the 23rd from SE steering NW all sail set the fore
sails Middle and Latter Part strong breeze
a few light signals of rain thick in sight
Lat 25.54 Long

Wednesday First Part a fresh breeze from SE steering
the 24th NW all sail set the fore and main top sails
Middle and Latter Part the wind East the Rose
in sight Lat 23.26 Long

Thursday commenced with a fresh which sail breeze
the 25th Middle Part blowing wind from SE and light
sails Latter Part a fresh breeze in sight
the Rose in sight Lat 21.26 Long 30.19

Friday First Part the wind moderate from
the 26th NW Middle Part from SE took Latter Part the
sails some pleasant weather Lat 20.18 Long 31.39

Saturday commenced with a moderate breeze from
the 27th the Northward took ship heads SE saw
a large ship steering to the Eastward put out
the main top sail Middle Part the wind light wind
from SE Latter Part at 7 PM the wind from NW
steered NW ship in sight thick and rainy
the 28th this day
