

Remarks on board ship Howard May 1841

Friday First Part. These 24 hours commenced
the 14 with a light wind from SSE to S, employed
N^o 940 in painting and running sails Middle
Part. light wind Latter Part. a fine
breeze from SSE employed in painting
ship inside, backing out, Lat. 22, 28 Long 60, 00

Saturday commenced with a fine breeze from SSE
the 15 steering N.W. painting ship Middle
N^o 941 and Latter Part. the same amount
of gulf wind Lat. 24 02 Long 61, 55

Sunday commenced with a fresh breeze from
the 16 SSE steering N.W. painting, sent a
N^o 942 brig steering N.W. Middle Part. the
wind variable from S to N. Latter Part. a
moderate breeze from S by E, Lat. 25, 29 Long 63, 11

Monday First Part. light wind from SSE steering
the 17 N.W. saw a brig steering to the N.E. Latter
N^o 943 Part. the same, saw a brig steering
N.W. painting the ship front side
Lat. 26, 29 Long 64, 23

Tuesday These 24 hours commenced with a moderate
the 18 breeze from SSE steering N.W. Middle Part.
N^o 944 the wind from S. to N.W. squally with
breeze, at sea the rain rather thick and cloudy the
sight from East, Lat. 27, 39 Long

Wednesday First Part. thick and cloudy the wind
the 19 from S. to N.W. inclined to haul more to
N^o 945. the weather rather Part. thick weather
and light rain
Lat. 28, 29 Long 66, 11

Bound to Nantucket from the Pacific May 1841

Thursday First Part. light air from SSE steering N.W.
the 20 unbleat the fore top sail mended it and
N^o 946 bent it, or in Middle and Latter Part.
Cabin finished painting outside & sail
in sight Lat. 28, 44

Friday First Part. commenced with a light
the 21 breeze from the N. with wind headed to
N^o 947 the weather mended the mizen
top sail. Middle Part. the wind squally
tacked to the eastward. Latter Part. a fresh
breeze with a bar sent. tacked to the N.W. mended
the fore top gallant sail, Lat. 28 38 Long 67, 39

Saturday commenced with a fresh breeze from SSE
the 22 headed for N.W. at 10 set the fore and mizen
N^o 948 top gallant sail ahead sea Middle Part.
squally Latter Part. a fresh breeze from
N.E. by E steering N.W. by N, Lat. 30, 00 Long 69, 24

Sunday First Part. a fresh breeze from N.E. by E
the 23 the top mast steering sail. Latter Part. Middle
N^o 949 Part. a fresh breeze from SSE Latter Part.
more moderate steering N.W. at the fore and
mizen royals, Lat. 32, 04 Long 71, 08

Monday commenced with a moderate whole sail
the 24 breeze from E by N steering N.W. saw a
N^o 950 shoal of porpoises, and a piece of sperm
oil and Latter Part. light wind from S.E.
saw the brig Ann from N.W. towards
Nantucket, Lat. 34, 00 Long 71, 56

Employed in painting the deck painting
