4 Monday

Wednesday Dec 2nd

This day commences with light winds from the south south west steering close to the wind. the watch at work putting on sliding sail gear blocks and making spungarn. in the afternoon, saw a school of black fish but did not lower the boats. and also saw a large white water bird did not know what it was. at sunset took in the top gallant sails fore and aft. the weather being with heavy squalls of wind so ends this day.

Thursday Dec 3rd

This day commences with light winds from the south south east steering close to the wind. the watch at work netting yarns and making spungarn and also fixing blocks and working in the ship. at five o'clock cleaned up decks. so ends this day.

7 Thursday

Saturday Dec 5th

This day commences with a good breeze from the south south east steering close to the wind. the watch at work picking over potatoes and painting the pen and fixing the rigging. at four o'clock washed of decks. so ends this day.

Sunday Dec 6th

This day commences with light winds from the south south east steering close to the wind. the watch at work doing nothing but reading. at sunset took in main top. the weather squally. so ends this day.

Monday Dec 7th

8 Friday

This day commences with strong winds from the south south east steering close to the wind. the watch at work breaking out water and other things. at five o'clock cleaned up decks and trimmed the sails so ends this day.

Tuesday Dec 8th

This day commences with a good breeze from the south east steering south west by west half west. the watch at work making spungarn and smothering and painting the iron boat. so ends this day.

Wednesday Dec 9th

9 Saturday

This day commences with a good breeze from the south east steering south west by west half west. all hands at work breaking out between decks and coaming the oil and storing it below. we got through at seven o'clock so ends this day.

Thursday Dec 10th

This day commences with a breeze from the southeast steering south west by south. the watch at work unlashing the spars and cleaning them and lashing some of them to the pole and mast. we then commenced laying of the sails and battens and scrubbing decks. we got through at seven o'clock and then trimmed sails and got our supper. so ends this day.
