

MARCH
18 Monday

Friday Jan 27th

This day commences with a good breeze. all hands at work cutting in the whale in the afternoon they lost a spade overboard lying on the larboard side and got it in getting along side stove the boat. we got all through cutting at dusk and then went to trying out the end this day.

Saturday Jan 28th

This day commences with strong winds. all hands at work breaking out and pumping salt water out and filling the tank with fresh and stowing down out and also mincing and trying out. so ends this day.

19 Tuesday

Sunday Jan 29th

This day commences with strong winds all hands at work stowing down oil and getting up stoves and trying out. so ends this day.

Monday Jan 30th

This day commences with strong winds from the north west steering close to the wind cruising. the water at work lashing casks and trying out in the evening we could down the pots and gave up trying. the wind blowing hard and sea running high all sail in but else reefed main topsail and foretopmast staysail so ends this day.


20 Wednesday

Tuesday Jan 31st

This day commences with a gale lay- ing to under short sail. all hands at work in the afternoon started the fire and went to trying out the wind going down fast at sunset trimmed sails and the water went low. so ends this day.

21 Thursday

Wednesday Jan 27th

This day commences with light winds from the westward. all hands at work stowing down oil and mincing and trying out and got through trying about 12 in the afternoon about 5 we saw a light whale off the lee side one the second mate  him and we turned about noon and to towing it we got him along side at none. and then put the fluke chain on and took in sail and then all hands went below the ship keepers standing the watch on deck. so ends this day.

22 Friday

Thursday Jan 28th

This day commences with light winds with some rain. all hands at work cutting in and clearing the decks a little. we got through cutting at five o'clock and then at 12 we got up watches for the night. we then left the ship at 11 and by 12 the wind commencing from the east with rain so ends this day.

Friday Jan 29th

This day commences with a good breeze from the westward steering the wind cruising. all hands at work mincing and trying out. and also breaking out the water casks out after 12 and did not find any. we broke out before 12 at the same time so ends this day.

23 Saturday

Saturday Jan 30th

This day commences with a strong breeze from the south west steering close to the wind cruising. all hands at work mincing a new seal on the larboard crane for the mate and putting the old one on the house. and then the water went low so ends this day.
