

December 1st 1842
Cape Horn Ship Hunter's Cove

1 Sunday

This day came with strong steering
quinnas and fog steering at P. P. A.
the wind south by E at 4 P. M.
the wind backed easterly the middle
part much the same at 6 P. M.
set down the main log sail
put on a pack and sent it up
and bent it again the latter
the wind steering double reef
the topsail fore and aft
so ends this 24 hours lat 42° 40' S

2 Monday

This day came with strong
wind and rain the wind
at 2 P. M. steering sharp on the wind
at 2 P. M. furl the fore and
main topsail and close reef
the main at 4 P. M. where ship
and reef the foresail at 4 P. M.
furl the foresail the wind blowing
at gale the middle and later
much the same so ends this 24 hours
lat 45° 0' S

3 Tuesday

This day came with E. gale of
wind blowing from the
at 5 P. M. steering sharp on the
wind at 4 P. M. where ship
at 5 P. M. all hands down to
square the main at the wheel got
three over the wheel about him
very bad. took him forward
and found his back part
and his back was hurt very
much dried him and bled him
at 11 P. M. furl the fore and main

topsail and took in Mast
the foresail the middle and later
part much the same so ends
this 24 hours lat 47° 0' S

This day came with a gale of
wind blowing from the N. W.
steering on the wind at 4 P. M.
at 4 P. M. set the topsail
the middle and later part
blowing very hard the wind
from the same quarter
so ends this 24 hours lat 51° 39' S

4 Thursday

This day came with a gale
of wind and rain squalls
the wind at 5 P. M. with close reef
topsails fore and aft
the middle and later part
the same blowing hard
at 11 P. M. where ship
so ends this 24 hours lat 52°

Friday

This day came with a gale
blowing from the N. W. with
close reef topsail fore and
aft nothing at coming in deck
to day the middle blowing the same
the later part very much
so ends this 24 hours lat 55° 2' S

Saturday

This day came with a gale of
wind blowing from the N. W.
at 5 P. M. where ship to the
at 11 P. M. the middle part the
same the later part blowing
and raining so ends this 24 hours lat 56° 12' S
