Thursday 3

This day began with light winds and fair weather steering W by N. saw some sulphur bottom wharfs at 11 A.M. toward dawn the boats and got more plenty of spots all round was land in sight on the lee bow so and this 24 hours lat 4

Friday 4

This day began with light winds and fair weather steering W by N. at 1 P.M. raised it sail on our weather beam she was down and spoke us it was the china of Seaboard and fisher-boat 25 boats and 1400 Spinn the mail and later part much the same so and this 24 hours lat 12 S

Saturday 5

This day began with light winds and fair weather steering W by N. at 1 P.M. raised it sail on our weather beam at 6 P.M. spoke her the bark Snyg of Seaboard 25 Mount 600 Sp in lat 12 S at 1 P.M. saw a sail on our weather beam the later part much the same so and this 24 hours

Sunday 6

This day began with light winds and fair weather steering W by N. saw black fish twice this day toward and got none the night and later part much the same so and this 24 hours lat 10

Monday 7

This day began with light winds and fair weather steering W by N. saw black fish several times the commenced stowing down Spinn oil and P.M. finished stowing and squashed of the decks at 5 raised black fish and wharfs toward fair then and did not see them
