Tuesday 18

This day bore with light
winds and fair weather
steering W by N the middle
and later part light winds
so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday 19

This day bore with light winds
and fair weather steering W by N
all hands employ'd in ships
doubly the middle and later
the wind light and nothing
much & evening so ends this
24 hours

Thursday 20

This day bore with light
winds and fair weather steering
W by S & M nothing much & evening
all the wind light at 4 in
the morning commenced steering
Spiral oil so ends this 24 hours

Friday 21

This day bore with fine weather
and light winds at 5 P.M.
finished stowing down oil
and then washed off decks
at 7 saw one fishback whale
the middle and later part
fine weather and the wind
light so ends this 24 hours

longitude for 1.45 Bourn fore

Saturday 22

This day bore with fine weather
and a dead calm bearing W. N. W.
the crew employ'd in diving but
little the middle part the wind
light at daylight saw land
an our weather beam vision
20 miles when call'd it the subject
island so ends this 24 hours

Sunday 23

This day bore with light
winds and fair weather steering
W by N the land still in sight
bearing W by N at the middle
and later part the wind
light so ends this 24 hours

Monday 24

This day bore with light
wind and fine weather
steering W by N at 5 P.M.
raised a school of spinner
whales let down 2 boats
and the waist boat got
past after some course and
turn'd him up and got him
a long side at 5 o'clock got
the flock chain'd him and
climb'd up the sails at day
light commenced eating in at
so got him cut in and all
hands meeting the whale head
so ends this 24 hours
