This Day born with a D.D. came
and fine weather steering
N.W. at 2 P.M. the deck clean
up and foretrailing out
commenced at 2 P.M. the later
part being so ends this 24 hours

Thursday 26
This Day born with fine weather
with a D.D. came heading N.W.
nothing in sight but
still boiling out so got down
boiling and cleaned up
the decks at day light
the later part light
winds so ends this 24 hours

Friday 27
This Day born with light
winds and fine weather
at 1 P.M. saw one fishback & hail
the middle and later part
a nice breeze so ends this
24 hours

Saturday 28
This Day born with light
winds and fine weather
steering N.W. at day light
all hands commenced stowing
down oil at 10 A.M. finished
stowing down and washed
of decks so ends this 24 hours

53
Saturday 29
This Day born with fine
weather and a strong breeze
N.W. at 1 P.M. we saw several
fin backs and at 2 P.M.
the men a boat swung out for
spinn wharls on the weather
bow toward down and got
near and the boats born on
board at 5 P.M. being dark
and cloudy the middle and
later part strong winds
and bad weather so ends
this 24 hours

Sunday 30
This Day born with strong winds
and rain squalls steering
on the wind at 6 P.M. we had
one heavy squall and let every
thing run fore and aft
running under close reef
topsails the middle and later
part it blowing quite
so ends this 24 hours

(May) The 1 1848
Monday 1
This Day born with a gale
of wind and heavy rain
at 2 P.M. set the fore and
mizen topsails the middle
and later part fine weather
being a fine breeze at
1 P.M. sent down the main
topgallensail and fly
get fore to mend
so ends this 24
