the wind light and foggy
no whaling done
So ends this 24 hours

Sunday 20th
This day born with light
winds and clear weather
at 1 P.M. the three masts
got to haul and his
line parted & was lost

his and coming on board he
picked up 8 wafe there being
fore ships in sight and plenty
of whales the middle part
light and foggy the later part
the watch employ'd in chasing
bore so ends this 24 hours
Thursday 22nd

This day born with light
winds and foggy weather
the watch employ'd in chasing
bore at 10 P.M. when spoke
the ship splended of edgar
down 22 Ments out 2000
when spoke the globe the
same time 21 Ments out
2000 bright whail the middle
and later part the wind light
and foggy and no whales
in sight this day so ends
this 24 hours

Friday 23rd
This day born with light
winds and foggy weather
all hands employ'd in chasing
nothing that is as much as we
can get along with the middle
part strong winds and foggy
weather the later part much
the same so ends this 24 hours

Saturday 24th
This day born with strong
winds and foggy weather
nothing a doing at 1 P.M.
when spoke the ship went to
of about 2000 21 Ments out
whail 400 Sp the middle part light
winds and clear weather the later
