Saturday the 9<sup>th</sup>

This day came with a gail of wind  
and very heavy sea on running  
under close reefed main topsail  
when about ship at 12 at night and  
when came at 12 very very rising  
in in the ship horrible of sweat hand  
the middle and latter part blowing  
a gail of wind and heavy raise  
so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 10<sup>th</sup>  
This day came with gail of wind  
and heavy raise at 4 in the  
caption of the uskis of came on board  
and took supper with him 3 sails  
in sight the part squally weather  
and heavy rain the latter part  
light winds and fine weather  
so ends this 24 hours

Monday the 11<sup>th</sup>  
This day came with light winds  
and fine weather this day us  
and the mile garring 5 other  
sail in sight the middle and  
latter part strong winds  
so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 12<sup>th</sup>  
This day came with light winds  
and fine weather laring of  
the streets 4 sails in sight  
and base all round us the middle  
and latter part the wind light and  
fine weather so ends this 24 hours

I think if we have  
A fair wind I think we shall  
get throo the streets  
But it is some what doubtful

Wednesday the 13<sup>th</sup>  
This day came with light winds  
and fine weather 4 sail in sight  
the middle and latter part light winds  
and heavy rain and fog garring  
with the uskis and the middle of  
1<sup>st</sup> Redford 40 miles this 24 hours  
Thursday the 14<sup>th</sup>

This day came with light  
winds and rain and fog 5 sail  
in sight and base on our  
be low base 6 by 1  
the middle and latter part light  
winds and thick fog so ends this  
24 hours

Friday the 15<sup>th</sup>  
This day came with light winds  
and thick fog carrying sail  
fore the boat sea nothing of course  
on deck the middle part came and fog  
the latter part we saw whails  
and it being foggy we did not low  
fore them so ends this 24 hours

Saturday the 16<sup>th</sup>  
This day came with light winds and  
foggy weather steering at 12 by 11  
The carpenter mending the masts boat  
that was tore by a whail the middle  
part thick fog the latter part  
much the same so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 17<sup>th</sup>  
This day came with light winds  
and fine weather we saw whails  
latter after them the middle and  
latter light winds and thick fog  
so ends this 24 hours lat 48.42 N
