Moscow the 17

This day born with light winds and thick fog & nothing & evening this forenoon but having wind & clouds the middle part light winds and fog the latter part light winds and fine weather when speeded a lot of horse secured decks fore to day so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 18

This day born with light winds and fine weather when saw one whale about and when several seen the middle part the wind light and fine weather the latter part much the same so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday the 19

This day born with strong winds and fine weather steering East & E... the carpenter mending one of the boats the middle and latter part the wind blowing fresh so ends this 24 hours lat 52.30

Thursday the 20

This day born with strong winds and fine weather steering East & E... when saw no whales this forenoon the middle part saw one or two past the ship the latter part light winds and thick fog so ends the 24 hours

Friday the 21

This day born with light winds and thick and nothing & evening all ships longing wind & clouds the middle part light the latter part at 4 o'clock we struck ice and the iron ground so ends this 24 hours

Saturday the 22

This day born with strong winds and thick fog at 1 o'clock spoke the ship heavy much of skin last case 2 Monts out with 200 of bright whal oil & 200 spin in at 10 o'clock when spoke the ship splendid of old town & 2 Monts out & saw Whales the latter part light winds and fog so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 23

This day born with light winds and foggy weather & sail in sight at 4 o'clock spoke the ship rowing fall at 6 o'clock down and did not strike so ends this 24 hours

Monday the 24

This day born with the light wind and fine weather at 1 o'clock when toward down and the main got fast and when turned back at 2 o'clock got him a long side of the ship at 3 o'clock and cut him out sure cause 3 other ships took whales a long side at the same time at 4 o'clock light the next morning when commenced sailing so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 25

This day born with light winds and fine weather & sail in sight at 5 o'clock when spoke the ship splendid of old town with at whal of long side the old man when it or bore of him at few minutes to have it what the middle it begins to snow and fog
