This day came with light winds and
fine weather one sail in sight the
middle and latter part the wind light
and variable so ends this 24 hours
lat 54 10 10

August the 8 With 1100 ft

Tuesday the 8

This day came with light winds and fine
weather steering on the wind at 2 P.M.
who spoke the ship William Thompson of
New Bedford who had 24 years
in whails to be seen yet the middle
and latter part light winds and clear
weather steering S by E so ends this 24 hours
Wednesday the 9

This day came with brisk winds and fine
weather at 2 P.M. who saw a few hump back
whails the William Thompson in sight
of us this 24 hours the middle and latter
part light winds and fog at 4 P.M.
who saw 5 bright whails who lay down
fore them so ends this 24 hours
Thursday the 10

This day came with light winds
and fog weather nothing in sight
at 2 P.M. 2 of our men got & fitting
and the old man put down one of them
in the rigging by the name of John
Baits and gave him 9 strokes on his
bare back the other man was hurt
very bad who could not get any thing
out of him fore some time who was
hurt in the head by throwing him
& faint at station in the fore castle
the middle and latter part strong winds
and thick fog so ends this 24 hours

Friday the 11
This day came with strong winds and
fog banks at 2 P.M. who spoke the ship
alert of New Bedford 12 months out
1500 Whail at 4 P.M. who spoke the ship
William Thompson of New Bedford
the middle and latter part light winds and fog
so ends this 24 hours
