

This day from with light winds and
 fine weather getting up whails in
 sight we hauled down 2 boats and
 the third mast got past and when
 got him at long side at 6 PM
 at 4 commenced hoisting at 5 at 6 comm
 putting 3 sails in sight so ends this 24th Nov

This day born with light winds and
fine weather at 4 o'clock we finished
cutting him in and made in sight
the middle and latter part it blowing
a gale of wind all hands being
bailing and whails & round us
so ends this 24 hours

This day came with strong winds
and fine weather but not fit
for whaling the middle and latter
part light winds and thick fog
the latter part we stowed down
one thousand barrels of oil 3 ships
in sight so ends this 24 hours

This being done with light winds and
foggy all hands employed in
stowing away sail and hoisting
the same time lashing with our
topsails on the cap. Blaken began
with 2 whistles the middle and latter
part the wind light and foggy
all hands employed in stowing
sail so ends this 24 hours

This danger, born with light winds and
fine weather, all hands employ'd
in stowing oil and boiling the
same time at 5 P.M. when spoke
the ship lives. Pool of New Bedford
and 4 or 5 other ships in sight and
wharves all round us. The wind
and latter part the wind light
and thick fog when finished boiling
at 5 P.M. so after this 24 hours

This Day born with light winds
and thick fog 4 ships in sight
we saw a few whail close to 5 PM
we lowered afters these but we
did not mark much by it at 7 and
ship past close to us a long line
and we a long line with 400 and 500
barrels on deck the middle and latter
part strong winds and rough weather
all hands employed in stowing down
oil so ends this 24 hours

This day commenced with a gale of
wind and clear weather and all
hands employed in stowing down
oil. 3 sails in sight and no other
observed the middle and latter part
light winds and thick fog and one
sail in sight a boiling when finished
stowing down at 4 P.M. and then
cleared up the deck so ended this
24 hours
