

Ship Sunday the 25 Sweetbiss
This day born with light winds and
foggy weather at 6 o'clock in sail from
the night one ship in sight a long line
the middle and latter part the wind blowing
fresh and plenty of fog nothing a
doing and but few whails a round
so ends this 24 hours

Saturday the 26
This day born with light winds and
cloudy weather at 4 o'clock spoke the
ship ~~Starbiss~~ of Edgar town full
bound home at 5 o'clock spoke
the ship champion of New Bedford
12 hours out 12:00 lost one man
killed by a whail the middle and latter
part it blowing it sail of wind
so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 27
This day born with it sail of wind
and thick weather 7 sails in sight
and no whails at noon and nothing
at dinner the middle part light winds
and fine weather at 4 o'clock we saw
a dead whail on our lee beam at 6
o'clock hooked on him and brought him
at long side he had him dead at hand
24 hours at 10 o'clock commenced cutting
in 6 sail in sight so ends this 24 hours

Monday the 28
This day born with light winds
and fine weather all hands
employed in cutting the whail got
at 6 o'clock got him out ice and saw
at way the wind and latter part
the wind light and fine weather
14 sail in sight some of sailing
and some of cutting and at 11 o'clock
the rest so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 29

This day born with light winds
and fine weather the whale are still a
long line and chasing whails
at the same time 12 sail in sight
and whails plenty of them at
noon at 4 o'clock finished sailing
and commenced breaking out the
fore part so ends this 24 hours

Monday the 30
This day born with light winds
and fine weather at 5 o'clock spoke
the ship ~~Starbiss~~ of New Bedford
bound off full at 6 o'clock spoke the
ship Olive Branch of New Bedford
bound off full at 7 o'clock spoke
the ship ~~Starbiss~~ of New Bedford
12 hours out 3:00 the middle part
the wind light and clear weather at
1 o'clock the boat of the Olive Branch
was at gunning with us and his
boat got it drift and he staid all
night on board of us. at 4 o'clock the
Olive Branch picked it up about
5 miles from us at 11 o'clock we got
fast to it whail so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 31
I have got some an idea that we
shall fill up the next cruise if we
have good luck it is a common talk with the
crew now we are now 11 months out
and I think we shall without any
doubt have got 1600 Barrels of oil
at present
