So Wednesday the 6

This Day came with light winds and fine weather plenty of whails all round us but we can't get fast to them so how they come under the water to dent's sail in sight & of them a bailing the middle and latter part the wind light and thick fog so ends this 24 hours

Thursday the 7

This Day came with light winds and fine weather at 5 PM we lowered down and the mist got fast and the whail took his line and the third rowit struck him again and the whail went off with 4 irons and 1 lance and 20 fathoms off him it came and sank and we cut from him and went on down the middle and latter part the wind light and heavy rain and thick fog so ends this 24 hours

Friday the 8

This Day came with strong wind and thick fog and rain so work a going on one Boat crew on deck to keep the ship from falling over board and to see the capers devil from eating up his drivers the middle and latter part the wind blowing fresh so ends this 24 hours

Saturday the 9

This Day came with light winds and fine weather 5 sails in sight leaving the ground all hands employed in scraping bones whails is getting scarce

Ship Huntress in the Ochat Sea ^{is the last of 48 hours}
the middle and latter part the wind light and fine weather in sight of land so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 10

This Day came with light winds and fine weather at 5 PM we had a new main topsail there being 1 sail in sight and no whails in sight that makes it bad at 7 PM we spoke the ship Macanick of New Port 21 months out 2000 lbs of the middle and latter part the wind blowing fresh so ends this 24 hours

Monday the 11

This Day came with light winds and fine weather mattering a drizzle at 4 PM we spoke the ship Liver Pool of New Bedford 14 months out 1000 lbs of Whail at 4 we spoke the ship Wasetaga of New Bedford the middle and latter part it blowing a gail of wind so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 12

This Day came with a gail of wind one ship in sight at 4 PM the ship Labrador was hard at 5 we lost the boat the whail boat ^{and} the bow boat and all the craft that was in them we took our fore topsail down and main spence all its rags nothing set on the ship but the mizen to keep her to the wind the middle and latter part the wind light and a very heavy sea and 2 sails in sight so ends this 24 hours
