

Wednesday the 13

This day born with light winds and fine weather at 2 P.M. we set the main topsail and the foresail at 5 P.M. we set the signal for the ship Sarritaga and an old man went on board to get a boat and one day she being full and being home the middle and latter part the wind light and fine weather 3 sails in sight all all hands employed in loading new sails and fitting 2 boats so ends this 24 hours

Thursday the 14

This day born with light winds and fine weather at 3 P.M. we saw one boat fast to a whail going to windward of our eyes at 5 P.M. we spoke the ship Liver Pool and the ship Sarritaga of New Bedford all agreeing together the middle and latter part the wind and fine weather so ends this 24 hours

Friday the 15

This day born with light winds and fine weather at 3 P.M. we spoke the ship Chorier of New London 55 old and 22500 Whil at 4 P.M. we saw them fast to a whail a mile from us agreeing the same time with the middle and latter part the wind light and foggy at 11 P.M. we spoke the ship Sigmore of New London so ends this 24 hours

Saturday the 16

This day born with strong winds and thick weather know whails to be seen on kind of at 3 P.M. we spoke the ship Henry Tomason of New London 14 old and 19000 the middle and latter part it blowing of gail of wind one ship in sight so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 17

This day born with light winds and rain know whails to be seen at 5 P.M. we hoisted our signal for a ship on our weather born to know what she was the middle and latter part the blowing fresh at 10 P.M. we split our main topsail and we sent it down so ends this 24 hours

Monday the 18

This day born with light winds and fine weather at 1 P.M. we hauled after a whail and run him off the ground all hands employed in mending the main topsail at 6 P.M. we hoist it again one ship in sight and one of our boats fast to a whail and he went off with three line of flocking the middle and latter part strong winds and rain squalls so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 19

This day born with strong winds and raining at 2 P.M. we spoke a french man with 2500 this season the middle and latter part the wind light and fine weather and 6 sail in sight so ends this 24 hours
