

Ship Huntsress in the Oct
Wednesday the 20

This day born with light winds and fine weather looking to see who saw a few whails and chased them 7 sail in sight 3 of. At 6 P.M. we saw one ships boats fast to a whail on our weather bow the middle and latter part the wind a blowing fresh and raising so ends this 24 hours

Thursday the 21
This day born with strong winds and foggy at 3 P.M. we past a barge a cutter in a whail 8 sail in sight the wind apart it blew a heavy gail at 4 in the morning we furled the foresail at 7 P.M. we furled the main top sail it blowing heavy raising now under the main spencer so ends this 24 hours

Friday the 22
This day born with a gail of wind and rain it blowing from the N.E. nothing in sight the middle and latter part the wind light and clear weather at 11 P.M. we spoke the ship Jefferson of Sag Harbor 14 boats and 23 with so ends this 24 hours

Saturday the 23
This day born with light winds and fine weather garrison with the Jefferson 4 sail in sight and a few whails of round but no whails there so for the middle and latter part the wind light and fine weather so ends this 24

Sunday the 25

This day born with light winds and fine weather steering N.E. at 1 P.M. we spoke the ship Morrison of New Bedford with 2 whails in the blubber room and a bailing at 2 we saw 2 right whail and we and the Jeffersons boats chasing of them and our old man whail are heard of him and had a gun there being 6 sail in sight the middle and latter part the wind light and fine weather 1 sail in sight so ends this 24 hours

Monday the 26
This day born with light light winds and fine weather at 1 P.M. we have in sight of a marian Island at 6 we took in sail of the mouth of the straits it looked like ~~Red Bank~~ it was going to blow a gail of wind it being night we did not dare venture there at 3 P.M. we took in the foresail at 6 we took in the main topsail it blowing a heavy gail and raising very hard and close to the land so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 27
This day born with a gail and heavy rain raising to under the main spencer and the ship laloring very hard at 2 P.M. we saw a ship close to us before we saw one another it being a thick fog she set her fire and run off a little from us the part the wind slacked a little the latter part the wind light and thick fog and plenty of rain so ends this 24 hours
