

Wednesday the 26th

This day born with strong winds and thick weather at 8 P.M. the wind shifted and blew out the A.M. at sun down we saw 4 sail and land on our lee bow distant 40 miles the middle and latter part the wind blowing fresh so ends this 24 hours lat 49.50 lon 100.00

Thursday the 27th

This day born with light winds and clear weather at 1 P.M. we sent down the main topsail to mend at 6 we bent it and then squared away fore a ship at 4 we spoke her it was the ship larvae of sagharbar the middle and latter part light winds and fine weather so ends this 24 hours lat 48.50 lon 100.00

Friday the 28th

This day born with light winds and smoky weather at 1 P.M. the Capt of the ship larvae came on board of us and we had a gun there being 6 sail in sight and one of them a biling the middle part the wind light and foggy the latter part the wind blowing fresh we put off again here land 5 sail in sight so ends this 24 hours

Saturday the 29th

This day born with strong winds and fine weather steering E by S at 2 P.M. we saw the land at 6 we got in the passing and the wind fell to a calm at 8 P.M. we took in every thing but the foresail and the foremast staysail the latter part it blowing a heavy gale and rain a calm so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 30th

This day born with a heavy gale and heavy rain at 6 P.M. we took in the main topsail and the same time the lee left parted and it came very near throwing the men off the rigging at 6 P.M. we carried away our fore staysail so ends this 24 hours

Monday the 1st

October the 1st

This day born with a gale off wind and no rain, one sail in sight of us on our lee beam a rowing very heavy the middle part the wind light and fine weather the latter part much the same so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 2nd

This day born with light winds and fine weather steering E by S at 1 P.M. we sent down the fore topsail and mended it and 6 P.M. we sent it up and bent it nothing seen to day the middle and latter part the wind blowing fresh so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday the 3rd

This day born with a gale of wind and heavy rain at 1 P.M. we took in the fore and main topsail and closet mended the main at 6 P.M. we took in the main topsail and foresail it raining and blowing very hard and now have to under two small sail the middle part strong winds and fine weather at 10 o'clock all sail steering E with wind force and as much as we could carry on her so ends this 24 hours
