This day born with strong winds and fine weather steering to at 2 P.M. when we saw one sail on our larboard quarter steering the same as when the middle and latter part a fine breeze and fine weather so ends this 24 hours

Friday the 5

This day born with a fine breeze and fine weather steering to at 2 P.M. when we saw the fore top mast star sail on our larboard quarter in making currents for the ship the middle and latter part brisk winds and fine weather steering to so ends this 24 hours

Saturday the 6

This day born with brisk winds and fine weather steering to nothing much a driving very easy times a boat ran the middle and latter part much the same so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 7

This day born with light winds and thick weather the wind a blowing from the east night a heavy fog as the middle and latter part light winds and heavy rain so ends this 24 hours

Monday the 8

This day born with strong winds and rain steering to at 2 P.M. when we saw the wind howled up with heavy squalls and rain at 5 P.M. when we took in all the light sails and close reefed the fore and main topsails it blowing a gale of wind the middle part it blew very heavy the latter part it blew a moderate breeze so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 9

This day born with a strong breeze and clear weather steering to at 2 P.M. when we saw the wind howled up with heavy squalls and rain at 5 P.M. when we took in all the light sails and close reefed the fore and main topsails it blowing a gale of wind the middle part it blew very heavy the latter part it blew a moderate breeze so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday the 10

This day born with light winds and fine weather at 1 P.M. when we saw the wind howled up with heavy squalls and rain at 5 P.M. when we took in all the light sails and close reefed the fore and main topsails it blowing a gale of wind the middle part it blew very heavy the latter part it blew a moderate breeze so ends this 24 hours

Thursday the 11

This day born with a heavy gale and rain the ship sailing and laboring very hard the middle and latter part much the same the wind blowing N.W. and we steering to at 2 P.M. when we saw the wind howled up with heavy squalls and rain at 5 P.M. when we took in all the light sails and close reefed the fore and main topsails it blowing a gale of wind the middle part it blew very heavy the latter part it blew a moderate breeze so ends this 24 hours

Friday the 12

This day born with a gale and rain the ship sailing and laboring very hard the middle and latter part much the same the wind blowing N.W. and we steering to at 2 P.M. when we saw the wind howled up with heavy squalls and rain at 5 P.M. when we took in all the light sails and close reefed the fore and main topsails it blowing a gale of wind the middle part it blew very heavy the latter part it blew a moderate breeze so ends this 24 hours
