Sunday the 14

This day began with a heavy gale and clear weather at 4 P.M. the wind hauled a little aft and the wind a little sail and steered to S.W. the wind S.W. by W. evening now under close reefed fore and main top sail and fore sail and a heavy sea and the ship running one side under and there the other the middle and latter part much the same

so ends this 24 hours at 12.10

Monday the 15

This day began with light winds and fine weather steering S.W. by E. all hands working a little in the rigging at 4 the weather squally and the took in the light sails at 11 the took and double reefed the top sails fore and aft the middle and latter part much the same so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday the 16

This day began with light winds and clear weather at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to the S.W. the wind right aft and squally evening under close reefed top sail and fore sail steering S.W. by E. the middle and latter part much the same so ends this 24 hours at 10.15

Wednesday the 17

This day began with light winds and fine weather steering S.W. nothing much a doing but eat and sleeping and night and little of that the middle and latter light wind squally weather so ends this 24 hours

Thursday the 18

This day began with brisk winds and rain the water upland in mending sails and other sundries at 4 P.M. the took all sail the wind being a head and coming on a gale the middle part it being a gale and heavy rain at 4 P.M. the took all sail the wind aft steering S.W. and clear weather so ends this 24 hours

Friday the 19

This day began with strong winds and rain squalls steering S.W. with the wind aft at 2 P.M. the saw a school of black fish the middle part strong winds and fine weather at 4 P.M. the sent down the main top galen sail and repaired it so ends this 24 hours at 12.10

Saturday the 20

This day began with strong winds and fine weather at 4 P.M. the bent the main top galen sail and sent down the fore top sail and bent a weather the latter part strong winds and fine weather at 4 P.M. the sent down the main top sail to mend the latter part the day fine weather and fine winds

so ends this 24 hours
