Tuesday the 31

This day began with fine weather still beating in between the slaves and getting nowhere trying to get to Moke by beating against a 4 not carried the middle and latter part much the same so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday the 1

November the 1

This day began with light winds and fine weather a drifting wind. The sea up very high at 10 P.M. we got our anchor down in the harbor up Moke so ends this 24 hours

Thursday the 2

This day began with fine weather at 1 P.M. we came with Darging line so ends this 24 hours

This day began with fine weather all hands on board no liberty today so ends this 24 hours

Sunday the 5

This day began with fine weather at 2 P.M. we took our anchor and sailed from honnalula the ship Richman left the same time with a cargo. The Dutch counsel of make to be moved at honnalula
