This day born with light winds and fine
weather steering N. the middle and
latter part strong winds and rain
at 4 P.M. when shortened sail down
to a double reef fore and main topsail
so ends this 24 hours

Monday 7
This day commenced with strong
winds and clear weather the wind
N. the middle and latter part much
the same so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday 8
This day born with strong winds
and fine weather at 4 P.M. when
saw the ship *Agoda* of New Bedford
all hands employed in mending
sails the middle and latter part the
weather much the same so ends
this 24 hours

Wednesday 9
This day born with strong winds
and fine weather the wind S.W.
when steering N. the watch employed
in making sprun gear the middle and
latter part laid in sight of the Orion
rocks ~~discovered~~ discovered by the ship *Orion*
of Lancaster the ship *Huntress* of New
Bedford in the year 1844 in company
with one another so ends this 24 hours

Thursday 10
This day born with light winds and
heavy rain at 6 P.M. when saw the land
of the Japanese sea at 11 the wind
hauled a head and when took in sail
down to a double reefed topsail
so ends this 24 hours



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Sunday 11
This day born with ~~light~~ strong winds and fine weather
at 10 P.M. when saw the ship *Advent* of New
Bedford at 12 the captains took each of them
a boat and went on shore at the mouth
of the Japanese straits so ends this 24 hours

Monday 12
This day born with light winds and fine
weather beating three the streets of
Japan with 12 sail of shipping in
sight at 10 when run down and spoke
the *Breganza* of B. and the captain went
on land for a game so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday 13
This day born with strong winds and
heavy rain 2 sail in sight the middle
and latter part blowing a gale the
wind shifted round to the S.W.
at 5 P.M. when double reefed the
topsails fore and aft and furled
the mainsail and reefed the foresail
so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday 14
This day born with strong winds and
clear weather at 4 P.M. when spoke
the ship *Henry* Thompson of N.B.
at 5 P.M. when spoke the *liver* of
harve a french man sailing
so ends this 24 hours

March 14 the commence studding
boats crew

Thursday 15
This day born with strong winds
and heavy snow we laying to
a wide blast reef main topsail
the middle and latter part much
the same so ends this 24 hours
