

Ship Hunted in the Japan sea
Saturday 7

This day born with light winds and fine weather at 8 o'clock we hove to and after whaling the third mast struck and the iron drew at 10, he fastened too a weather and the line got foul and we had to cut the line and let him go so ends this 24 hours

Sunday 8

This day born with light winds and fine weather saw a few whails to day and hove to after them at 4 o'clock we sent down the main topsail and hove to a weather so ends this 24 hours

Monday 9

This day born with strong winds and thick weather hove to after whails at 10 o'clock we saw 4 gannets at 5 o'clock we came up with one of them his cone was 5 ft high he went a cross our bow so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday 10

This day born with light winds and hazy weather large land in sight distant 40 miles the eastern land we got fast too 2 whails and the iron drew from them one of them then broke the forth masts steering ore and the tub ore and knocked the forth mast out of the boat and not hurt him the Boegansy close too as the captain went on board of him so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday 11

This day born with light winds and heavy rain and thick fog sailing to under light sail so ends this 24 hours

in the lat 40° and longitude 136° 21' E
Thursday 12

This day born with a gail of wind from the N & we saw a land surring before it making bad weather of it so ends this 24 hours

Friday 13

This day born with strong winds and fine weather plenty of whails in sight at 4 o'clock we made sail the wind backing away at 9 we saw a land steering S.W. so ends this 24 hours

Saturday 14

This day born with a gail of wind from the W blowing on the E side of the Japan sea 15 miles from the land shore the latter part the wind light and a heavy sea land in sight on our lee quarter distant 12 miles so ends this 24 hours

Sunday 15

This day born with light winds and fine weather plenty of whails a round of land hove to after them to day and that was our share of them so ends this 24 hours

Monday 16

This day born with light winds and rain at 10 o'clock the mast struck and killed him at 11 o'clock we got a long line at 4 o'clock the Surge of P.B spoke us 8 o'clock and clean at sun down we got him in so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday 17

This day born with light winds and fine weather plenty of whails under 4 o'clock 2 ships in sight and 10 fathoms the captain went on board of one of them so ends this 24 hours
