This day born with light winds and thick weather 3 sail in sight and 3rd whails a noise and not much a rising so ends this 24 hours

Saturday 12

This day born with light winds and fine weather the watch employed in mending sails 3 sail in sight and one of them cutting in a whail at 4 o'clock the old man down and down a boat and went on board the border of A.B. so ends this 24 hours about 39th 40

Sunday 13

This day born with light winds and thick weather saw 3 fine boats 2 sail in sight we goered with the corner in the afternoon so ends this 24 hours lat 42nd 40

Monday 14

This day born with light winds and thick fog at 10 o'clock we saw the land the main land it is called the Wood dy land the the capt. there circulated on getting water there but the wind being light and foggy so we stood off again the captain of the border came on board of us the latter part of the day so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday 15

This day born with a gail of wind from the N.E. one ship in sight the middle and latter part much the same looking to a wider east much water tap sail so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday 16

This 24 hours much the same rising raining and foggy the ship border still in sight so ends this 24 hours

Thursday 17

This day born with strong winds and fog and rain the middle and latter part much the same so ends this 24 hours

Friday 18

This day born with light winds and fine weather one sail in sight at 11 o'clock we saw a streaker 3 points on our weather beam we run for him and took him a long ride and some more cutting him and and we found him to be a we cut in one of his legs and let him go the latter part thick fog so ends this 24 hours

Saturday 19

This day born with light winds and fine thick fog with a heavy rain plenty of one live a ship firing a cannon and we answer with a half a dozen more the latter part the fog lit up and we saw 2 ships one on our weather beam and the other on our lee bow distant 8 miles the latter part thick fog and light winds

so ends this 24 hours land in sight

Sunday 20

This day born with light winds and clear weather at 2 o'clock we had a game with the border of A.B. steering S.E. and 4 sail in sight so ends this 24 hours

Monday 21

This day born with light wind and fine weather at 3 o'clock 3 sail in sight and we got 20 barrels of water out of the border of A.B. at 4 o'clock we spoke the ship Dover of New London 10 points out 10050 S 20000 sail so ends this 24 hours lat 43rd 25

Tuesday 22

This day born with light winds and fine weather at 10 o'clock we lowered down and the Beckerit shot struck we got them a long ride at 11 o'clock and cut him in by sundown so ends this 24 hours
