This day born with light winds and fine weather at 8 PM we commenced long lining the ship condor in sight she got fast and and lost time at 5 PM the captian came on board of us and took supper.

so ends this 24 hours

Thursday 24

This day born with a gail of wind at 8 we had to coole down the masts on account of the rain and heavy sea the latter part the wind light and foggy started the masts again and finished at 12 PM so ends this 24 hours

Friday 25

This day born with light winds and fine weather the watch employed in chasing down at 8 PM we saw the land the ship condor in company with us at 6 the condor here to and the old man went on board at 9 he came on board so ends this 24 hours.

Saturday 26

This day born with light winds and thick weather in the streets of Senous and the wind light and at head what there is of it came all round us and ship in sight so ends this 24 hours at 4 PM 59 PM long 8

Sunday 27

This day born with light winds and fine weather the middle and latter part much the same so ends this 24 hours

Monday 28

This day born with light winds and fine weather all hands employed in staming down oil the middle and latter part much the same so ends this 24 hours at 4 PM 34 PM

Tuesday 29

This day born with light winds and fine weather 2 sail in sight at 4 PM one of our men departed from this life we took and washed him and laid him out so ends this 24 hours at 4 PM 24 PM in the 2nd sacklin sea in sight of land

Wednesday 30

This day born with brisk winds and fine weather at 8 PM we made preparation for a burial we had a back our main yard and the capton of the boner came on board and the captian a chapter in the bible and a prayer and then launched the him in the mighty deep never to be seen any more

at 10 PM we saw about 80 miles of ice we had a boat to shoot seal there being plenty of them on the ice but we could not get nigh them so ends this 24 hours

Thursday 31 lat 47.36

This day born with light winds and fine weather the middle and latter part much the same the latter part gaining with the condor N.B so ends this 24 hours at 4 PM 24 PM

Friday the 1. 1849

Saturday 1

This day born with bad weather cold and raining at 4 PM we spoke the ship larant and Ontario of New London the Ontario 10 PM out 300 PM the larant 12 PM out 1000 PM all hands a gaining and a nother sail in sight the latter part light winds and fine weather so ends this 24 hours at 4 PM 24 PM

Saturday 2

This day born with light winds and fine weather 4 sail in sight the ship Ontario struck and sunk her the latter part at 12 PM they struck a nother and then it came on fog so ends this 24 hours at 4 PM 24 PM
