and had a game so ends this 24 hours

Monday 7th
This day began with light winds and
fine weather looking for whail so ends
this 24 hours

Tuesday 8th
This day began with light winds and
thick fog the middle and latter part fine
weather & sail in sight and no whail
so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday 9th
This day began with light winds and fine
weather the middle part at 10 we spoke the
Margann Susan of Southampton Bound off
fool whails in the blubber room
so ends this 24 hours lat 59° 40'
