Saturday July 15<sup>th</sup> 1848  
Begins with lite breez from the  
S.E. and foggy. Middle and  
later Part the same Lat. 56.45  
Saw 2 Whales bound the boats could not  
fasten so ends the day

Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> Lite breez from  
the S. and foggy. Middle and  
later Part the same Lat. 57.52 Long 145.45

Monday 17<sup>th</sup> Lite breez from the S.W.  
Lan. W.C. Middle and later  
Part the same so ends no Ob

Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> Lite breez from the  
N. Middle and later Part the  
winds S. Lat. 57.16 Long 146.45

Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> Still lite breez from  
the South. Middle and later Part  
Strong breez from the S.E. Lat  
57.52

Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> Strong breez from  
the S.E. Lan. N.C. Middle and  
later Part the same so ends the day

Friday 21<sup>st</sup> Still Strong breez from  
the S.E. Lan. N. Middle and later Part  
the same so end the day. Lat. 56.00  
saw whales bound the boats fastened  
and drewed Spoke ship *Mexicack*  
800 lbs

Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> Still Strong gale  
from the S.E. Middle and later  
Part more moderate Spoke  
Ship *Boena* of Hull 3000  
lbs.

The *Sachalin* Sea  
Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> Lite breez from the  
S.W. Middle and later Part winds  
N.W. Saw whale bound and took  
one *Resheim* whale Spoke Ship  
Morse of New Bedford. S. whale  
Lat. 56.20 Long 150.15

Monday 24<sup>th</sup> Lite breez from the  
N.W. and Pleasant weather. Middle  
and later Part the same saw 2 or  
3 whales could not fasten Lat. 55.35  
Long 150.25

Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> Lite breez from the  
N. Middle and later Part the winds  
Strong from the S.W. Saw whale  
bound the boats struck and killed one  
and took him to the Ship

Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> Strong breez from  
the S.W. and thick weather. Middle  
and later Part the same Lat 55.49  
Spoke *Friend* 1200

Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> Still Strong breez from  
the S.W. and thick weather. Middle and  
later Part the same Spoke Ship  
*Mary* and *Susan* of Stonington  
1300 lbs. Lat. 56.00 Long 57.07

Friday 28<sup>th</sup> Still Strong breez  
from the S.W. Middle and later  
Part the same no Ob.

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> Lite breez from  
the S.W. Middle and later Part  
Lite breez from the Eastward  
No whales in site so ends the  
day
