

Wednesday 16th of August 1848
Begins with brisk breeze from the
N. Middle and late Part moderate so
ends the day. Saw whales toward the
boats struck 2. Killed one and took
him to the ship spoke ship Splen-
did 3000 lbs. wanting one cubit

Thursday 17th Lite breeze from the N.
Middle and late Part Strong breeze
Saw whales toward the boats struck and
killed one and took him to the ship
Lard 30. mib dirt Lat. 46. 26.

Friday 18th Brisk breeze from the
N. Middle Part the same late Part calm
Saw whales toward the boats could not fasten
land in site so ends the day

Saturday 19th Lite breeze from the
S.E. Middle and late Part the
winds Strong from the South
Lat. 46. 20 Land in site

Sunday 20th Strong breeze from
the South Middle and late Part
More moderate saw whales did
not leave so ends the day. No Ob.

Monday 21st Begins with lite
anes from the N. and foggy Middle
and late Part the same saw whales
could not fasten 46. 50. Spoke Lumpy 1000

Tuesday 22nd Strong breeze from the
South and foggy saw whales
toward the boats could not fasten
so ends the day B sail in site

Wednesday 23rd Begins with Strong
breeze from the South and foggy
Middle and late Part Strong breeze
from the N.W. so ends the day

Thursday 24th Strong breeze from the
N.W. Middle and late Part foggy

Friday 25th Lite breeze and foggy
Middle and late Part Strong
breeze from the N.E. spoke
Ship Splendid and Champion
Champion 12. lbs. Saw whales
toward the boats could not fasten

Saturday 26th Strong breeze from
the N.E. Middle and late
Part the same no Ob Land in site

Sunday 27th Strong breeze from
the N.E. Middle Part More moderate
late Part calm Picked up a dead
whale Lat. 46. 17.

Monday 28th Calms the first Part
of this day. Middle and late
Part Brisk breeze from the S.E.
spoke Ship Chevy of Newy
mk. 400 lbs. Penumbra 4. whales
Monticini 1000 lbs. Saw whales
could not fasten so ends land
in site 47. 16.

Tuesday 29th Brisk breeze from
the N. Middle and late Part
the same spoke Ship Anchor. food
and board off Olive Branch De
saw whales could not fasten so
ends the day.
