Wednesday 21st 1859. Commences with
lite on 3 and calm. Middle and
later Part the same Lat. 23.55 Braganza

Thursday 22nd The first Part of this day
balm & Middle and later Part the
same Braganza in 60

Friday 23rd Calm the first Part of
this day. Middle and later Part lite on
Lat. 24.10. Long 132.07. Braganza in 60

Saturday 24th Lite breezes from the South
Middle and later Part winds N.W.
Lat. by Dr. 24.00. Braganza in 60

Sunday 25th Brisk breezes from the W
S.W. from N.W. Middle and later
Part more moderate Lat. 24.11. Long 132.38
the Ship B. of. N.B. in 60

Monday 26th Calm. Middle and
later Part the winds Brisk from
the S.W. Lat 28.35. Long 134.55

Tuesday 27th Calm Middle and
later Part Brisk breezes from the
N.E. Lat. 29.35. Long 135.29 B. in 60.

Wednesday 28th Lite breezes from the N.E.
Middle and later Part the same
at 9 A.M. Lited some of the Luck
in Islands at dusk Land 10 miles Dist
Spoke Ship Trident of McIntosh
1000 lbs 26 Mo dist Middle
Braganza in 60

Sea Feby 1859

Thursday March 1st 1859
Commenced with lite on 3 from the N
& heading in for the land Middle
Part. 10. 11. Land 10 miles off Middle
and later Part Brisk breeze from the
E. at 12 Mo. the Islands from N.W. Dist
8 Miles Lat. 29.16 Braganza in 60

Friday 2nd Strong breezes from the
E. Sun. N.W. Lat. dusk. Land S.E.
and N.E. Dist 10 and 20 miles
from N.W. Middle and later Part
Heavy gales from the N.W. Lay to
under closed reefed Mo. 3 Sail and 3.3 Stay
Main Spencer Braganza in site so ends

Saturday 3rd Strong gales from the N
N.W. heading N.W. S. under close Reef
Mo 3. Sail 3.3 Stay and Mo Spencer
Middle and later Part. the same at 8 A.M.
Mo seat closed Reefed 3.3 Sail and
Reefed Forasail Land 10 miles off
Lat. 29.11. Long by Chron 129.15 last site of B.
Braganza

Sunday 4th Strong gales from the N
N.W. heading N.W. Middle and later
Part the same land in site Lat. 28.46. Long 128.46

Monday 5th Still Strong gales from the N
N.W. heading up N.W. S. Middle and
later Part heading up N.W. S. and
N.W. so ends the day Lat. 28.32

Tuesday 6th Lite breezes from the E N.E.
heading N Middle and later Part
winds N.E. from N.W.E. at 10.
A.M. wind N. heading E.N.E.
so ends the day no Ob.
