

Ship Hesperus in the Lapan

Tuesday March 20th 1849.

Begin with brisk breeze from the South Middle and later Part the same saw whales could not faster Lat. 37.47. Long 152.52

Wednesday 21st ft. lite breeze from the South and Pleasant weather Middle and later Part the same Lat. 37.55. Long 153.20
Saw whales could not faster.

Thursday 22nd. fine lite breeze from the S.E. and Pleasant weather Middle and later Part the same saw whales could not faster Lat. 37.00

Friday 23rd. strong breezes from the S.E. Middle and later Part the same with Rain Saw whales did not loan so ends

Saturday 24th. Strong breezes from the Eastward with Rain Middle and later Part strong gales from the S.W. Lat. 37.35. Long 153.45
Saw whales did not loan so ends

Sunday 25th. Strong S.W. gales. Middle and later Part more moderate saw whales, heard could not faster

Monday 26th. Strong gales from the S.W. Middle and later Part more moderate saw whales, could not faster Lat. 38.33

Tuesday 27th. lite breeze from the S.W. Middle and later Part winds W. Saw whales heard & fastened & cut on account of its being night. so ends the day Lat. 38.55 Long 153.15

Sea March

Wednesday 28th. lite breezes from the North & fine weather Middle and later Part the same saw whales could not faster Spoke Ledgeon Hauland 23 whales Lat. 38.30

Thursday 29th. Brisk breezes from the South Middle and later Part the same Spoke Ship. Glande Price of New Bedford. 300. lbs. no whales this day Lat. 39.04

Friday 30th. Brisk breezes from the S.W. Middle and later Part the same saw whales could not faster Lat. 38.15. Long 154.15

Saturday 31st. Brisk breezes from the S.W. Middle and later Part winds N.E. W. Saw whales could not faster Lat. 38.40

Sunday April 1st 1849
commenced with brisk breezes from the E. Middle and later Part Strong gales from the E. Saw whales could not faster so ends Lat. 39.09. Long 153.10

Monday 2nd. lite breezes from the N. Middle and later Part the same Spoke George and Henry New London 2 whales. Brought on clean so ends the day. No Ob.

Tuesday 3rd. Heavy gales from the W. Middle and later Part the same no Ob.
