

Ship Greenleaf Lin
Sailed April 17th 1849
Began with strong breeze
from the Eastward Middle
and later Part winds W. Saw
whales could not fasten Lat. 39.22.

Wednesday 18th Still strong breeze
from the Westward Middle and
later Part the same Lat. 39.22 to 139.00
Saw whales could not fasten so ends

Thursday 19th Lite breeze from the
S.W. Middle and later Part
strong gales from the S.W. Saw
whales fastened to one and lost a
line Lat. 40.05 Dist 20 Miles
Lat. 39.43

Friday 20th Still strong gales from
the S.W. Middle and later Part mor-
derate Lat. 40.05 Long 139.00 Saw
whales could not fasten so ends

Saturday 21st Lite breeze from the
S.W. Middle and later Part
the same Saw whales could not
fasten Lat 40.18 Long 139.00 ends

Sunday 22nd Lite breeze from
the S.W. Middle and later
Part strong gales from the W. Saw
whales could not fasten Lat. 41.04

Monday 23rd Strong gales from
the W. Middle and later Part
the same Saw whales could not
fasten Lat. 41.03 Long 138.46

Ship Laper Lee
Sailed April 24th Strong breeze
from the N. Middle and later
Part the winds moderate from the South
Saw whales could not fasten Saw a dead
whale Picked him up so ends the day

Wednesday 25th Lite breezes from the
South Middle and later Part winds
S.E. spoke ship. C. J. Balmage of
seventh beam Lat. 40.50 no whales
in site this day

Thursday 26th Brisk breezes from
the S.E. Middle and later Part heavy
gales from the S.W. Saw whales

Friday 27th Heavy gales from the
Westward Middle and later Part
the same Lat. 41.25 Long. 139.00

Saturday 28th Strong gales from the
Westward Middle and later Part
more moderate Lat. 40.32 Long 139.11
Saw one whale a going quick to the
Westward

Sunday 29th Lite breeze from the
Westward Middle and later Part
the winds E. Lat. 39.50 Saw
whales could not fasten Parted
the line spoke Forenek Bark
Salamander

Monday 30th Strong breeze from
the Eastward & thick Rain
Middle and later Part strong
breezes from the N.E. Saw whales
Did not leave Lat. 39.35 Long 135.40
