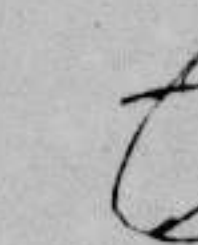

 Sunday 29th Lite breez from the S.W. and blew Land in site both sides of the Sealp and to the head of Do. Middle and later Part fine clear weather Saw one or two Reeshu whals going quick B said in site so ends the day Land 10 miles East

 Monday 30th fine breez from the S.W. and blew Middle and later Part. Saw one or two whals could not fasten Land 10 miles Spoke Per Group wanting for bl. to fill so ends the day No Obs.

 Tuesday 31st Common with calm Middle and later Part Strong breez from the South and foggy Saw one or two Reeshu whals did not loon

 Wednesday August 1st Common with strong breez from the South and foggy Middle and later Part the same saw Reeshu whals got one

 Thursday Begins with fog Middle and later Part blew Spoke Bladen of New Bedford so ends Land 10 miles

 Friday 3rd Lite breez from the North Middle and later Part thick weather and winds South so ends the day

 Saturday 4th Brisk breez from the South and foggy Middle and later Part the same saw Reeshu whals could not fasten Spoke Barker hauler of Muelich
