Sunday August 17th 1847
 Begins with fine breezes from the N. & Middle and later Part the same Saw 2 or 3 Rishu whales could not put

Monday 20th fine breezes from the S.W. Middle and later Part strong S.W. winds and foggy so ends the day

Tuesday 21st Strong S.W. winds and Rainy thick weather Middle and later Part the same so ends the day No Obs.

Wednesday 22nd Lite breezes from the N. & Middle and later Part Pleasant and calm No whales this day

Thursday 23rd Begins with lite breezes from the S.W. Middle and later Part Strong gales from the S.W. so ends the day

Friday 24th Lite breezes from the S.W. Middle and later Part calm so ends

Saturday 25th Strong gales from the S.W. and thick weather Middle and later Part the same

Sunday 26th Still Strong gales from the S.W. and foggy Middle and later Part the same

Monday 27th Strong S.W. gales and thick weather Middle and later Part the same

Deaf Up Sacrae

Tuesday 28th of August 1847
 continues with Strong gales from the N.E. Sleering S.W. Middle and later Part the same James Hart a Native of the Sandwich Islands died this day

Wednesday 29th Still Strong gales from the North Middle and later Part fine breezes from the North Lat. 18.27

Thursday 30th fine breezes from the North Middle and later Part Strong gales from the N.E. Lat. 57.28 so ends the day

Friday 31st Still Strong gales from the North East Middle and later Part the same Spoke Ship Superior 700 lbs. so ends Lat. 57.16

Saturday August 1st 1847
 Begins with Strong gales from the N.E. Middle and later Part the same Lat 55.51 Long 153.26

Sunday 2nd Brisk breezes from the N.E. Middle and later Part More moderate Lat. 54.40

Monday 3rd Lite breezes from the N.E. Middle and later Part the same Lat. 53.16 saw 2 Rishu whales did not leave

Tuesday 4th Lite breezes from the N.E. Middle and later Part Strong breezes from the South Picked up a dead whale Lat. 53.03
