

Ship's Account In the

Septemb. 5th 1849 Commenced
with strong south winds at 8 P.M.
the Fluke blew fast and we lost
the whale from a long side Middle
and later Part heavy gale from the S.E.

Thursday 6th Heavy gale from the S.E.
Middle and later Part from the N.W.

Friday 7th Still heavy gales from
the N.W. Middle and later Part
the 5th winds more moderate Lat. 54.27

Saturday 8th Lite breezes from the South
Middle and later Part strong breezes
and foggy

Sunday 10th Strong S.W. winds and
foggy. Middle and later Part Mon
Moderate & winds from the North
Lat. 50.36 Long 148.20

Monday 11th Lite breezes from the N.
Middle and later Part calm so ends
the day Lat. 49.41 Long 148.26

Tuesday 12th Begins with lite ares from
the S.E. Middle and later Part
the same Lat. 49.41 Long 150.28

Wednesday 13th Still lite breezes from
the S.E. Middle and later Part
strong breezes and foggy.

Thursday 13th Strong breezes from
the S.E. Middle and later Part
the same with fog

Friday Septemb. 11th 1849
Commenced with brisk breezes from the
North. Middle and later Part lite
breezes from the Eastward Lat. 47.57
Spoke Navy 1250 lbs of Oil Food etc
2000 lbs. saw whales could not
fasten Lat. 58.00

Saturday 15th Lite breezes from
the Eastward Middle and later
Part the thick foggy weather winds
S.W.

Sunday 16th Strong breezes from the
N.W. and foggy. Middle and later
Part the said spoke ship Wm
Bell 1000 lbs. at 10 P.M. Boat off
with the said ship for the Sand-
wich Islands at 11. Do Lited Chankin
Island bearing South Dist 55 Miles
at Dark the N.E. end of the Island
bearing S.E. Dist 15 Miles and a
small Island bearing E.S.E. Dist 12 Miles
Saw whales board the boats struck one
and the line parted Lat. this day 51
Ob. 47.33

Monday 17th Commenced with lite ares
from the N.W. the ship heading S.E.
Between Maskin Island and Koton Mid-
dle and later Part calm (drifting)
between the Islands so ends the day Spoke
Dover of Newfoundland 1600 lbs. and
15 Miles N.W.

Tuesday 18th Lite ares from the
Eastward. breezes S.E. Middle and
later Part strong gales Lat
by Ob. 55.35 Long 152.46
By the Land 55.30
