February 17th 1850.

Begin with Strong gales from the S.W. by E. by S. Middle and later Part the same No. 10.

Tuesday 18th Still gales from the S.W. by E. Middle and later Part the same at 11 A.M. a most Menaceably accident happened on board the ship William Perkenwood fell from the Main yard overboard and was (Proceeded) Lat. 56.17 Long 78.00 west

Monday 11th Still Strong gales from the Westward by E. by S. Middle and later Part the same so ends the day one sail in site Lat. 56.47 Long 75.00

Tuesday 12th Still Strong gales from the W. by E. by S. Middle and later Part the same Lat. 56.43 Long 70.00 west

Wednesday 13th Still Strong gales from the W. by E. by S. Middle and later Part the same Lat. 56.21 Long 65.40

Thursday 14th Brisk breeze from the N.W. by W. by S. Middle and later Part winds N. and rainy

Friday 15th Strong gales from the W. by N. Middle and later Part the same Lat. 58.53 Long 160.00

Saturday 16th Still Strong gales from the N.W. heading N.E. by E. Middle and later Part the winds N Lat. 52.27 Long 57.12

Begin with Brisk breeze from the N.W. by W. heading N.E. Middle and later Part winds N.W. by W Lat. 50.59 Long 55.52

Monday 18th Brisk breeze from the N.W. by W. heading N.E. Middle and later Part the same so ends the day Lat. 49.03 Long 53.10

Tuesday 19th Brisk breeze from the N.W. by W. heading N.E. Middle and later Part Lite winds Lat. 47.22

Wednesday 20th Brisk breeze from the Eastward by W. Middle and later Part winds N.E. by W Lat. 45.40

Thursday 21st Strong gales from the N.W. by W. heading N.E. Middle and later Part the winds N.W. Lat. 44.06 Long 50.08 West

Friday 22nd Brisk breeze from the W. by N. Middle and later Part winds S.W. Lat. 41.17 Long 38.34

Saturday 23rd Strong gales from the South by W. Middle and later Part the same Lat. 38.47 Long 48.11

Sunday 24th Brisk breeze from the South Middle and later Part winds W so ends the day Lat. 38.33 Long 47.52
