Monday 1st Lite breeze from the S.W. breeze N.E. Middle and later part winds N.E. Lat. 31.35 Long 51.14
Saw a shoal of sperm whales toward the boat could not farther so ended the day & sail in sight

Tuesday 5th Brisk breeze from the N.E. beating to the windward. Middle part strong breeze from the N.W. later part the same and raining etc. 12. Mercaderes we were struck by a Whirl wind and lost our men

Wednesday 6th Begin with strong gales from the S.W. breeze N.E. Middle and later part the same Lat. 29.30 Long 40.13

Thursday 7th Strong breeze from the E. S.E. breeze N.E. Middle and later part the same Lat. 27.01

Friday 8th Still strong breeze from the N. breezing N.W.E. Middle and later part the same Lat. 25.45 Long 38.46

Saturday 9th Begin with Brisk breeze from the N. Middle and later part the same Lat. 25.34 Long 36.30

Sunday 10th Brisk breeze from the North Middle and later part the same Lat. 25.25 Long 34.25

Monday 11th Brisk breeze from the N. breezing E. Middle and later part the same Lat. 25.30 Long 32.25
