Sunday February 2nd 1851.
at anchor in Half Moon Bay,

Monday 3rd at 10th O'clock Took over
anchor and proceeded to sea in leaving
up one of the anchors parted the chain
about 20 fathoms from the anchor and
lost the anchor and the piece of chain.
This day ends with brisk breezes from the
S. by E.

Tuesday 4th lite airs and calms land in
sight Dist. 50 miles W. by N. so ends another day

Wednesday 5th Strong gales from the S.W.
Lat. 35° 16' 18'

from the S.W. spoke ship Briton of Salem
Bedford 2000 lbs 100 lbs Lat. 35.00 Long 152.50

winds from the South

the Meridian of Greenwich this day and day
