the first part of these 24 hours strong breeze the middle and latter part more moderate at 6 AM saw the Land bearing E by N Dist of 20 Miles the Ship at that time heading E by S

the first of these 24 hours moderate breeze the middle and latter part calm at 6 AM saw Whales at 7 AM heard the boats but got none the Land in sight about 10 Miles Dist

1832
the first part of these 24 hours pleasant weather the middle and latter part strong gales at 6 PM shorting sail at 3 AM close reefed the topsails fore and aft at 9 AM tuck in the fore and mizzen topsail

Thursday
April
the 6
year
1832
the first part of these 24 hours strong gales the latter part more moderate at 1 AM tuck in the fore and mizzen topsails at 6 AM set them again dished reefed at 10 AM set the jib and main sail

year
1832
the first part of these 24 hours strong breeze the middle and latter part light breezes and cloudy at 10 AM saw number of hump backs

Saturday
the 8
year
1832
all these 24 hours pleasant weather and fine breezes saw a large number of hump backs of the Sulphur Islands
