thick in the main sail and main top gallant  
sail Lat 32.47 North Long 153 33

the middle and latter part more moderate  
at 4 PM saw Whales heard and  
got one saw tow side

moderate breezes cut in saw Whales and  
began boiling out

breezes we knock out the after hole and  
stade down our sail

saw Whales heard tow boats but  
no them no more at 11 PM  
spoke the Ship Eclipse of London

middle and latter part more moderate saw on  
sails and several forebacks and other small fish

saw number of forebacks and hollers and one  
carcass of a whale at 10 AM took Ship  
and steered to the North

and equally the middle and latter part light  
breezes and calm  
Lat 31 59 North Long Long 152 39

small sporting fish without the fore sail  
and repandit and lost it again  
Lat 32 41 North Long 152 19 E

middle and latter part light breezes  
saw number of forebacks without the  
main sail and repandit and lost it  
again Lat 32 54 North Long 152 11

and light breezes hinds saw granber  
at 1 PM saw Whales heard  
and got tow
