Thurs day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather
 July the 20 day and light breezes at 5 P M began
 cutting at 10 P M got them in
 year 1832 Lat 33 41 North Long 152 27

Satur day the first part of these 24 hours fine
 July the 21 day pleasant weather the latter part light
 squalls of rain at 1 P M saw a
 year 1832 whale heard two boats but
 with no success in getting him
 Lat 33 51 North Long 152 51

Sund day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather
 July the 22 day and light breezes fine sailing saw
 one sail and several finbacks
 year 1832 Lat 33 36 North Long 152 31

Monday the first part of these 24 hours fine
 July the 23 day pleasant weather light winds and
 calm the latter part strong breezes
 year 1832 squally and rainey
 Lat 33 20 North Long 152 11

Tues day all these 24 hours strong breezes squally
 July the 24 day and rainey saw number of plank.
 24 day afloat heard and picked up a stick
 year 1832 of timber 16 feet in length and 10
 inches square
 Lat 33 47 North Long 152 19

Wednes day the first part of these 24 hours
 July the 25 day strong breezes the middle and
 latter part more moderate saw
 year 1832 a whale heard and got by us
 Lat 33 31 North Long 152 44

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Thurs day the first part of these 24 hours fine
 July the 26 day pleasant weather and light breezes the
 middle and latter calm
 year 1832 Lat 33 52 North Long 152 37 E

Fri day the first part of these 24 hours calm
 July the 27 day the middle and latter part light
 breezes and fine weather saw several
 year 1832 finbacks and other fish of the whale
 kind Lat 34 46 North Long 153

Satur day the first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant
 July the 28 day weather and light breezes the middle and latter
 part squally rainey and strong breezes
 year 1832 saw number of finbacks
 Lat 34 49 North Long 153 19 E

Sund day the first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant
 July the 29 day weather the middle and latter part strong
 breezes saw several finbacks and one sail
 year 1832 to windward of us
 Lat 34 52 North Long 152 41 E

Mon day all these 24 hours strong breezes and squally
 July the 30 day and some rain saw sail to windward of us
 standing to the N E at 4 P M
 year 1832 we beat the main topgallant sail and
 went another way
 Lat 35 51 North Long 152 07 E

Tues day all these 24 hours strong breezes
 July the 31 day squally and rainey spoke the ship
 year 1832 of Laredo with four whales
 along side eating in
 Lat 33 34 North Long 152 23
