pleasant weather saw several finbacks

August
the 25 day
year 1832
the first part of these 24 hours
strong breezes and squally the
middle and latter part fine breezes
and pleasant weather set up the main
siggie Lat 32 15 North Long 156 11

Sunday
August
the 26 day
year 1832
all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather
and fresh breezes saw several finbacks
and grampuses spoked the Ship Hesper
of New Bedford
Lat 31 46 North Long 156 57

Monday day
August
the 27 day
year 1832
the first part of these 24 hours
fine weather and light breezes
the latter part strong breezes
all hands in play in fiteen the
fore and main top mast and top
gallant siggie
Lat 31 26 North Long 157 33

Tuesday
August
the 28 day
year 1832
the first part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant weather the middle and
latter part squally and rainny
saw one sail Lat 30 51 North

Wednesday
August
the 29 day
year 1832
all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather and light breezes saw several
small breeches spoked the ship
Hesper of New Bedford
Lat 30 49 North Long 158 08

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Thursday day
August
the 30 day
year 1832
the first part of these 24 hours fine
breezes the middle and latter part
light breezes and calm saw one sail
Lat 30 20 North Long 159 23

Friday day
August
the 31 day
year 1832
all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather
and light breezes spoked the Ship Hesper
at 7 P.M. with two small Whales
along side Lat 30 41 North Long 159

Saturday day
September
the 1 day
year 1832
the first part of these 24 hours strong
breezes squally and rainny the middle and
latter part more moderate at 5 P.M.
saw Whales leave and got one
Lat 30 53 North Long 159 37

Sunday
September
the 2 day
year 1832
the first part of these 24 hours light
breezes the middle and latter part
strong breezes saw Whales heard the
boats and saw them no more
Lat 31 11 North Long 159 57 8

Monday day
September
the 3 day
year 1832
all these 24 hours strong breezes
squally and rainny saw along
number of finbacks and jumpers
Lat 31 24 North Long 160 47 6

Tuesday
September
the 4 day
year 1832
the first part of these 24 hours
strong breezes squally and rainny
the middle and latter part fine
pleasant weather and light breezes
saw the Ship Hesper sailing
Lat 31 47 North Long 162 37
