September
the 5 day
year 1832 all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and fine breezes saw several finbacks and companions spoke the Ship Leaper

September
the 6 day
year 1832 all these 24 hours light breezes and fine weather saw several finbacks and other sporting fish of the Whale kind
Lat 31 52 North Long 163 37

Fri day
September
the 7 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours light breezes and calm the bottom part squally rainier and strong gales at 8 P M took in all sail split the main top sail
Lat 31 47 North Long 163 51

Satur day
September
the 8 day
year 1832 the first part of the 24 hours calm and light squalls with rain the middle and bottom parts strong breezes fresh all sail both the main top sail doubled reefed
Lat 31 21 North Long 164 11

Sun day
September
the 9 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours strong breezes the middle and bottom part more moderate
Lat 30 42 North Long 164 30

Monday
September
the 10 day
year 1832 all these 24 hours strong gales and squally and at 6 P M took in all sail but the main top sail
Lat 31 08 North Long 164 52

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Tues day
September
the 11 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours strong breezes squally and rainier the middle and bottom part more moderate set the topsails double reefed and main sail full and sprancer
Lat 30 51 North Long 165 19

Wednes day
September
the 12 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours strong breezes and squally the middle and bottom part more moderate made all sail and in bent the fore top sail and sent it down to repair
Lat 30 28 North Long 165 32

Thurs day
September
the 13 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours light breezes squally and rainier the middle and bottom calm saw one sail and one finback
Lat 30 47 North Long 165 48

Fri day
September
the 14 day
year 1832 all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and light breezes we bent the fore top sail and bent another in the place of it
Lat 30 23 North Long 166 32

Satur day
September
the 15 day
year 1832 all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and light breezes we bent the fore sail and bent another in the place of it
Lat 29 34 North Long 166 47

Sun day
September
the 16 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and light breezes the middle and bottom the breeze more strong saw Whales at even
