October fine pleasant weather and light
the 2 day breezes the middle and latter
year 1832 part the same spoke the ship
Yankee *Phoenix* of *New Bedford*
I felt bound home

October weather and fine breezes spoke
the 3 day the *Phoenix* again and got five
year 1832 barrels of beef out of her

year 1832 Lat 31 07 North Long 170 42

October strong breezes the middle and latter

Saturday all these 24 hours strong gales
October and squally took in all sail but
the 6 day the four top sta sail at 1 tick
year 1832 set the main top sail
Lat 30 18 North Long 172 43E

October strong gales the middle and latter
the 7 day part more moderate set the four
year 1832 sail and four and nine top sail
oldest reef
