the 22 day
year 1832 All these 24 hours strong breezes
and equally at 2 P.M. we hoist
the fore top sail and hoist
another sea sail
Lat 32 27 North Long 171.42

Tuesday
October
the 23 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours
moderate breezes and equally the
middle and latter part calm
set the top gallant sails
Lat 31.47 North Long 167.53

Wednesday
October
the 24 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours
calm with every heavy swell
the middle and latter part
fine breezes and pleasant weather
Lat 32 17 North Long 167.42

Thursday
October
the 25 day
year 1832 all these 24 hours light breezes
and calm with every heavy
the 25 day will knock out the two decks
and make one strong
Lat 31 38 North Long 169.18

Friday
October
the 26 day
year 1832 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
breezes and calm weather saw
one sail this day took a lower
observation made the Long 166.20
Lat 31 25 North Long 168.47

Saturday
October
the 27 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant breezes the middle
and latter light breezes or
mainly calm
Lat 30 13 North Long 166.20

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Sunday
October
the 28 day
year 1832 All these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather and light breezes all
hands employed in scraping and
painting the hull and spinnies
Lat 30 07 North Long 165.47

Monday
October
the 29 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant weather the middle
and latter light breezes all hands
employed in scraping and paint-
ing Ship saw one sail
Lat 29.51 North Long 164.38

Tuesday
October
the 30 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours
calm or very light breezes the
middle and latter part fine
breezes the watch employed
in painting Ship
Lat 29 17 North Long 163.40

Wednesday
October
the 31 day
year 1832 the first part of these 24 hours
fine breezes saw one foreback
the middle and latter part
strong breezes and equally
Lat 28 02 North Long 164.53

Thursday
November
the 1 day
year 1832 all these 24 hours strong breezes
equally and rainier at 10
P.M. took in the top gallant
sails and hoisted up the top sail
Lat 28 18 North Long 159.14

Friday
November
the 2 day
year 1832 all these 24 hours strong breezes
equally rainier and thunder
and lightning took in all sail
Lat 28 27 North Long 158.28
